

2ND SOURCE WIRING AND CABLE COOKIE POLICY

This cookie policy is for 2nd Source Wiring and Cable.

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences over a period of time, so you do not have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

We have put our cookies into the following categories to make it easier for you to understand why we need them:

1. **Strictly necessary:** These are used to help make our website work efficiently, provide security features on our website, and provide services you have asked for.
2. **Performance/analytics:** These are used to analyze the way our website works and how we can improve it.
3. **Functionality:** These help to enhance your experience by remembering choices you have made concerning the features of the website (e.g., username, language, region you are in).
4. **Advertising/targeting:** These cookies are used to deliver advertisements more relevant to you and your interests. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organizations such as advertisers.

Cookies and You

If you choose not to enable cookies, you will still be able to browse our website, but it will restrict some of the functionality of our website or what you can do.
